# 1. Bug fixes

## 1.1 “NegativePrincipalForRepaymentException” is thrown when paying off a loan account with Reduce Number of Installments and capitalized fees

For a loan account with “Reduce Number of Installments” prepayment method and capitalized fees, an error message was thrown by the application when attempting to pay off the entire loan amount.

The issue is now fixed and the pay off operation can be made successfully for the accounts with RNI and capitalized fees.

## 1.2 “Adjust Payment Dates” option is not editable when switching the Pre-Payments Recalculations method to Reduce Number of Installments

Once the “Reduce Number of Installments” method has been implemented for the DBEI products, at the product level there was only one schedule editing option available - “Adjust payments dates”. When the user transitioned from a method that allows all three editing options to RNI, “Adjust payments dates” was not editable.

This issue is now fixed and the user is allowed to edit this option when transitioning from another prepayment recalculation method to RNI.
